

Bylaws for PAM Chapters

Article I Purpose

To uphold and promote on the local level the purposes and objectives of the Presbyterian Association of Musicians as defined in its Constitution, Article I, Section 3.

Article II Membership

Chapters may be formed at synod or presbytery level or other geographical areas as may be deemed advisable. Members of chapters must be members of the Presbyterian Association of Musicians.

The chapter treasurer will send names and addresses of all new chapter members to the PAM National Office for confirmation of current membership in PAM. Chapter members must join the national organization through the PAM National Office.

Article III Officers

Section 1. Elected Officers The chapter shall elect at least the following officers:

1. President
2. Secretary
3. Treasurer

These officers shall be elected for a term of two years, and may be elected for one additional consecutive two-year term, after which a year must elapse before they are eligible for re-election to that office.

Article IV Chapter Expectations

Section 1. A local chapter remains active by fulfilling the following expectations:

1. Organize and sponsor at least one event per year
2. Submit to the national office by March 15 of each year an annual

report including a list of chapter officers and a summary of activities during the previous calendar year.

3. Submit to the national office by July 1 of each year a roster of chapter members for verification of membership in the national organization.
